INVESTMENT **highlights**

PROPERTY

North Fork Site 8 is a Tier 4 site on a 31-acre parcel with a 14-acre pad. The pad can support approximately 330,000 SF of buildings. The site has gone through the Virginia Business Ready Sites Program (VBRSP) and is now pad-ready and offered below market rate.

UTILITIES

The following utilities are located proximate in the Park and available for tie in:

- Electrical: 3-phase underground distribution circuit with 12MW of available capacity. A circuit upgrade to 62300kW (62.3MW) would take approximately 18 months.
- Gas: 6" line with 90 PSI
- Water: 12" line
- Sewer: 16" line
- Fiber: On-site with dark fiber available

PAD READY SITE

The University of Virginia Foundation received a \$3M VBRSP grant to advance site readiness at North Fork. That site work is complete.

SPEED TO MARKET

With a majority of the site work completed, a user will be able to deliver a facility 6-10 months faster.

PROXIMITY TO HIGHLY SKILLED WORKFORCE

Located in Albemarle County and along the innovation corridor, a user will benefit from a highly skilled labor force. This allows for increased production efficiency, innovation, adaptability, and economic growth.

COST

Site 8 is being offered below market value.



UNIQUE TO MARKET INDUSTRIAL LOCATION

This Tier 4 site is located in a market with strong barriers to entry and access to the largest site with public utilities within a 50-minute drive. It is located across the street from Rivanna Station home to NGIC, the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) and National Geospatial Intelligence Agency (NGA) the National Ground Intelligence Center.

North Fork is zoned as a Planned Development-Industrial Park that allows for a wide variety of uses - from light industrial to Class A office and laboratory buildings to support retail and hotel development, providing for as much as 3.7 million square feet of development. At present, North Fork is home to nine buildings totaling approximately 650,000 square feet of office, labs, flex space, and amenities. Site 8 will advance North Fork's mission by creating additional space for academic institutions, private industry focused on defense and biotech, and government agencies to come together, develop partnerships, and benefit from their proximity and talent.

The University of Virginia, a leading research institution receiving over \$549 million in sponsored research awards yearly, generates groundbreaking research discoveries aimed at tackling significant challenges in fields such as medicine, engineering, life sciences, education, business, and society. The University aims to enhance the impact of these innovations by collaborating with industry, government, new ventures, and other key partners to bring them to the public.

North Fork is located approximately 8 miles north of Charlottesville, directly adjacent to the Charlottesville Albemarle Airport and U.S. Route 29.



INTERSTATE CONNECTIVITY

I-64 and many four-lane highways, including **US 29, US 15, US 20, and US 33**, connect Central Virginia to major interstate highways, **I-95, I-81, and I-66**, to easily reach more than 50% of the nation's consumers, population centers and major markets.

MAJOR INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS AND US ROUTES

- Interstates 64 and 66 connect Central Virginia to Interstates 81 and 95 for access to north/south destinations
- Interstate 64 runs through the region, connecting Central Virginia to the Port of Virginia and destinations to the west
- Interstate 66 connects Central Virginia to Washington DC and beyond
- US Route 29 runs through most of the region - connecting Central Virginia to destinations from Florida to the Greater DC area

THE PORT OF VIRGINIA

The Port of Virginia is the third-largest port on the East Coast and the sixth largest in the country. It is comprised of four coastal terminals in Norfolk, the Richmond Marine Terminal in Richmond, and the Virginia Inland Port in Front Royal (60 miles west of D.C.).

The Port of Baltimore is the 13th largest port in the United States and the closest to the Midwest Region. The region is predominantly served by CSX and Norfolk Southern rail with 3,000+ miles of track. The extensive rail system supported by two Class I railroads synergistically supports the other facets of the region's excellent freight distribution infrastructure, including two major international ports, multiple intermodal transportation hubs and the broad interstate network.










ACCOLADES

CHARLOTTESVILLE OVERVIEW

Charlottesville is the economic anchor for the Central Virginia region and powered by the strength of top-ranked University of Virginia. Bordered by the Blue Ridge Mountains to the west, Charlottesville is home to an exceptionally skilled and educated workforce, due to the presence of two community colleges and the University of Virginia. Nearly 40% of the Charlottesville MSA's population has at least a Bachelor's degree and the quality of the workforce has attracted both startups and major businesses to the region, creating a vibrant and diverse economy. A city steeped in historic value, Charlottesville has raised three US presidents and is the home of the University of Virginia, founded by Thomas Jefferson in 1819 and consistently listed as one of the top five public universities in the country.
